barriers for faith communities

barriers for disability organisations

- ▶ Disability support workers navigating faith communities.
- ▶ Navigating cultural traditions
- ▶ Facilitating community and social inclusion.



risk perception & risk mitigation

- ▶ Underlying perception that people with disability cannot understand or comprehend faith or spirituality.
- ▶ How do we address the concerns of a society that is increasingly wary of religion?



solutions & strategies

- ▶ How can we work with people with intellectual disability, with and without families to understand and comprehend individual faith and spirituality needs?
- ▶ How can we work together to break down the limitations constructed by society about a person's ability to understand faith and spirituality?
- ▶ What do faith communities and support organisations need to know when assisting someone to attend and/or participate in a faith community?
