



Certificate I in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy provides learners who have low literacy and numeracy skills with the opportunity to build confidence and better engage with employment, community, learning and personal domains.

## course structure

Certificate I in Initial Adult literacy and Numeracy has been designed to allow for flexible selection of specific literacy and numeracy units. This is to maximise the opportunities for diverse learners with an intellectual disability to engage with learning.

To be eligible for 22293VIC Certificate I in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy, learners must successfully complete a total of 11 units comprising:

- 3 literacy units from the literacy units list
- 3 numeracy units from the numeracy units list
- 5 literacy and/or numeracy units from the lists that have not previously been completed.
